



It located between Europe and Asia on the border of five coastal countries: Azerbaijan, Iran, Kazakhstan, Russia and Turkmenistan. In addition to these countries with access to the Caspian Sea, the sea basin includes a colossal catchment area of more than 3 million km². This region stands out for its unique diversity of amphibians and reptiles under significant anthropogenic impact.
